The following software tools of the Institut für Theoretische Elektrotechnik:

CONCEPT-II (demo version), CONCIRC, CONMTL, CONMLS (demo version)

may be used free of charge as long as the following terms and conditions are agreed upon. By using the software the user agrees that the following terms and conditions are being met:

1. The software codes and their documentation (manual, examples and alike) are solely owned and distributed by the Institut für Theoretische Elektrotechnik, Hamburg University of Technology (TUHH), Hamburg, Germany. It is not allowed to distribute, sell, share, or make available any part of the code or the documentation to third parties.
2. The software tools may only be used for purposes that are strictly non-armaments related and in general only directed to improve science, technology and their appropriate application for the benefit of humanity. Any commercial usage, simulations for third parties on a for-profit basis, or for armaments related purposes are not allowed.
3. The software tools may be used within the same department / group on as many computers as wanted. Any distribution beyond the same department / group is not allowed.
4. The software tools are not free of errors nor does the Institut für Theoretische Elektrotechnik guarantee that its results are correct. Every user is responsible for carefully checking the validity of all results. The Institut für Theoretische Elektrotechnik cannot be held responsible for any consequences / conclusions from software simulations. If the user becomes aware of any error or malfunction the Institut für Theoretische Elektrotechnik should be notified.
